Breakdown of Sub-frame bolts and assembly components with part numbers

This information is specific to the data taken from my car (MK5 Golf – 1K Chassis) – 2004 Build Date. It was fitted with a Gen2 Steering Rack

Some part numbers will be a different variation or newer variation (letters change at the end), and some parts won't exist, this is just to help you identify bolts, and their position or what they're for because when you buy them from VW, you get all the bolts, but there's virtually no way to identify them other than their thickness and size, this hopefully should make it a bit easier for you.

The steering rack is normally purchased as a complete assembly, so some of these bolts specifically on the rack aren't important because you will need to purchase them individually to repair your rack, as you won't be able to get them at a dealer.

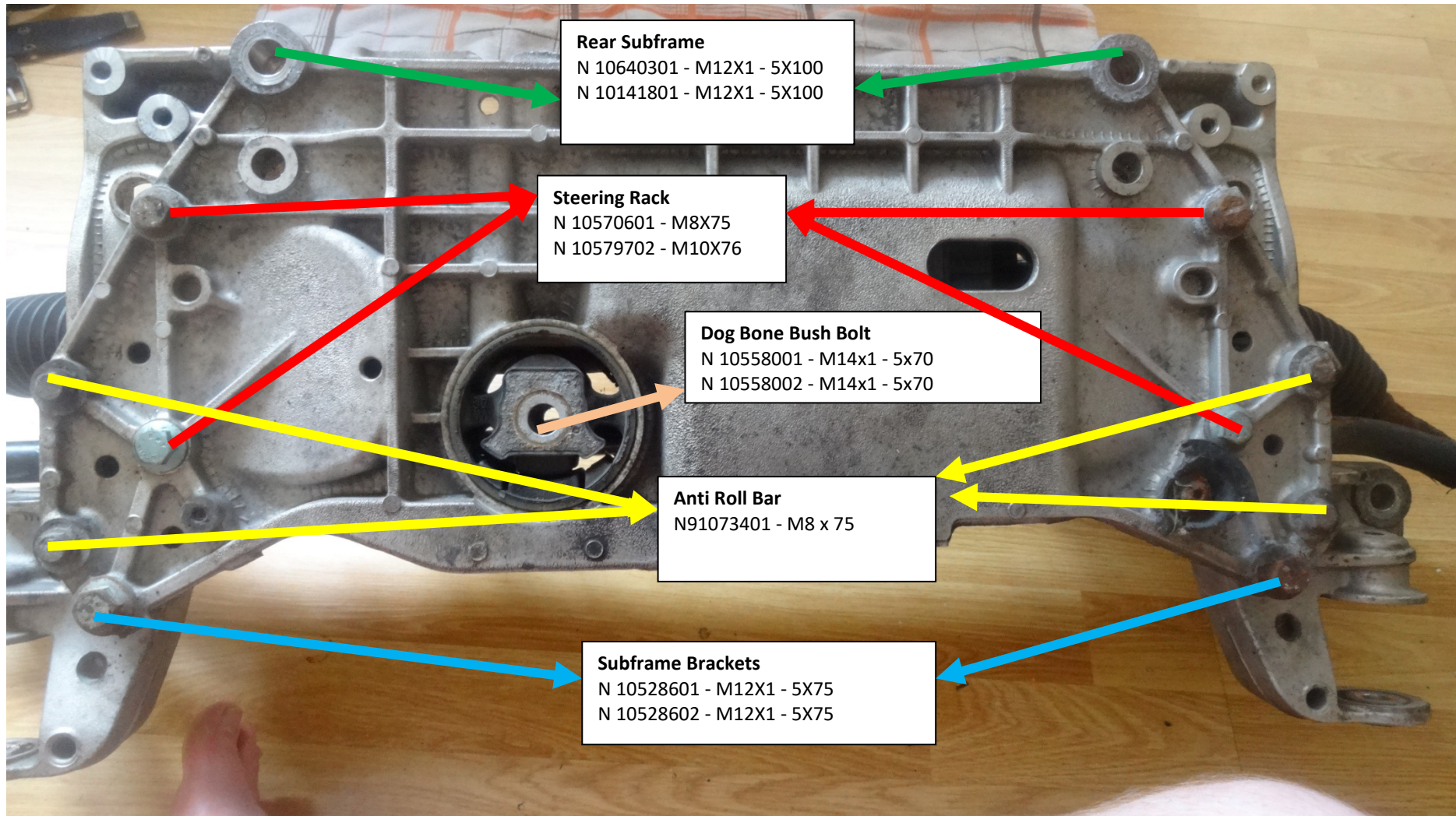

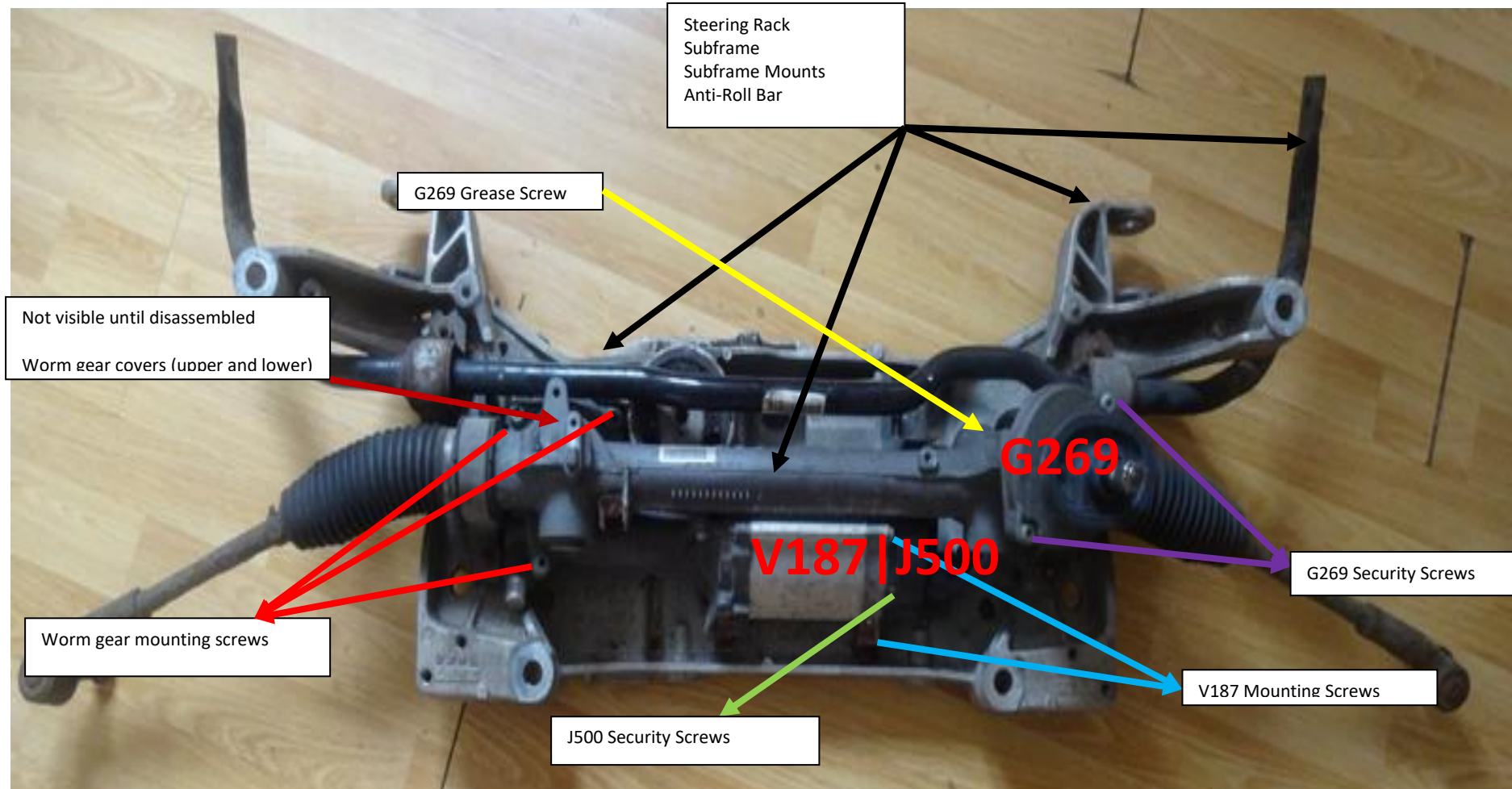
